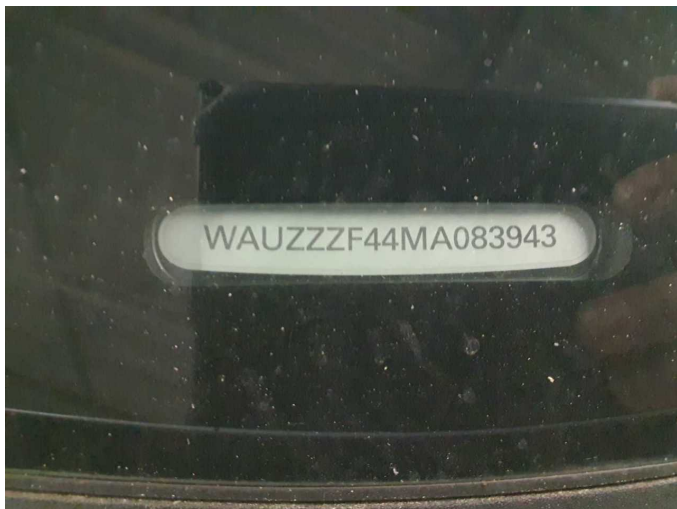


Figure 11: VIN

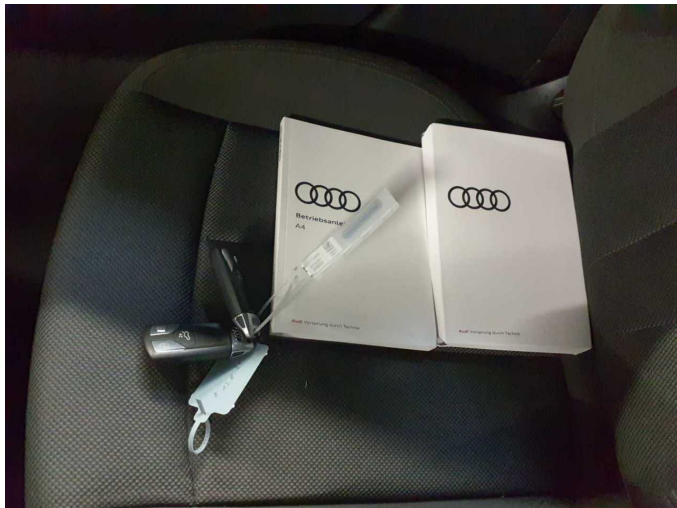


Figure 13: Documents

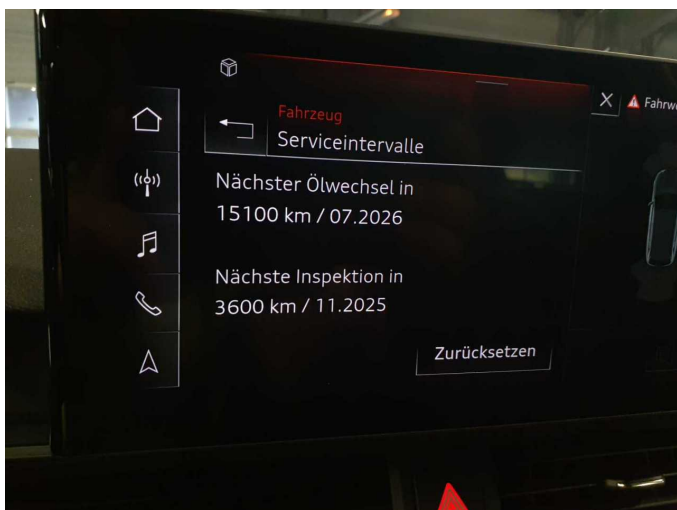


Figure 17: Misc.

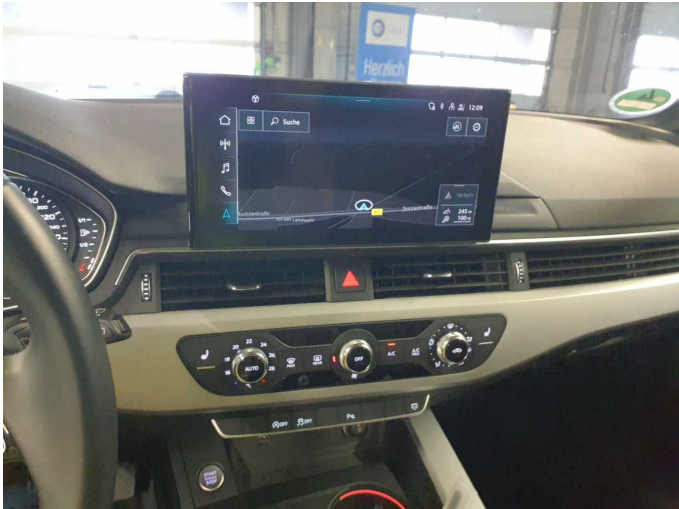


Figure 20: Misc.

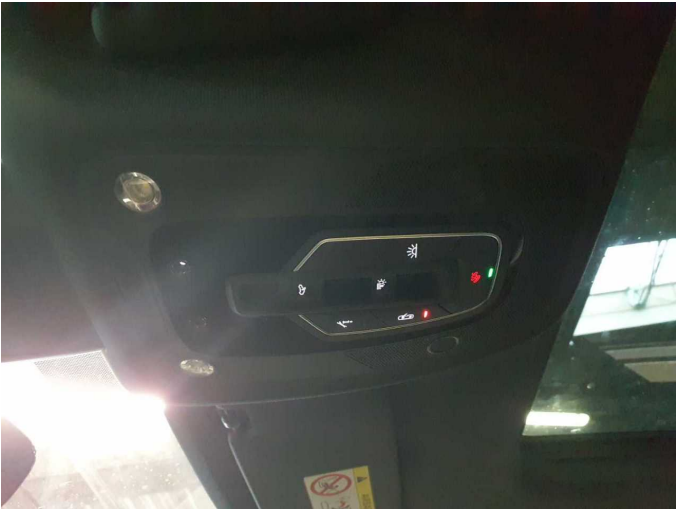


Figure 21: Misc.

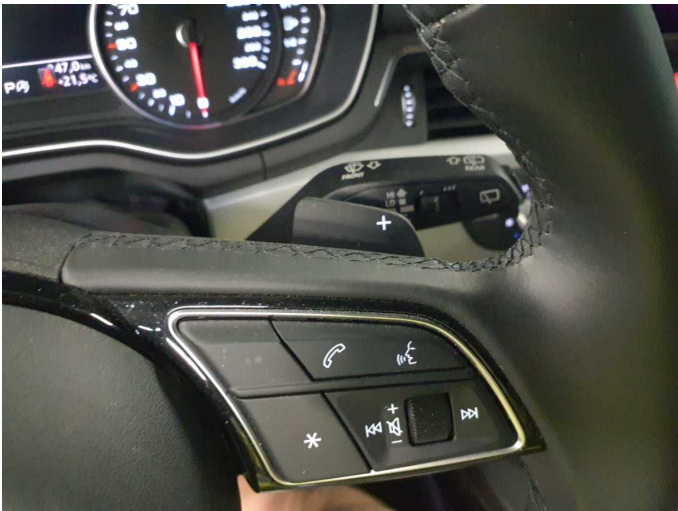


Figure 26: Misc.

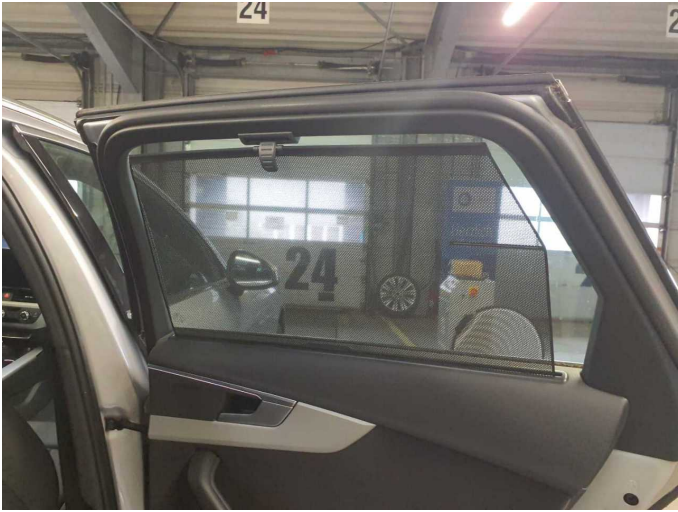


Figure 30: Misc.

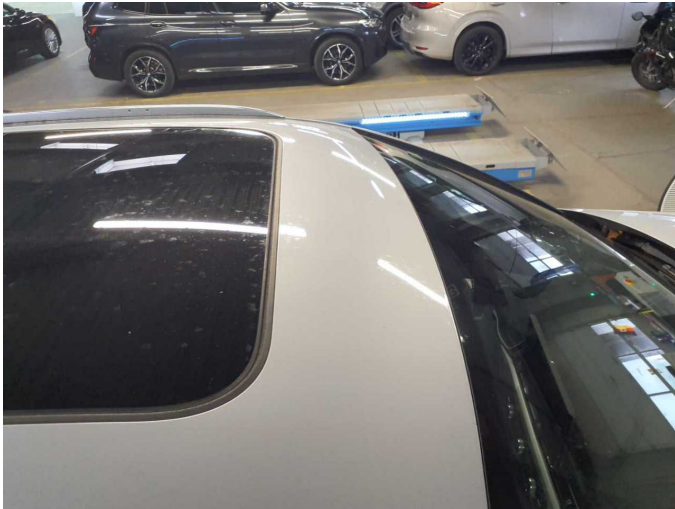


Figure 35: Misc.

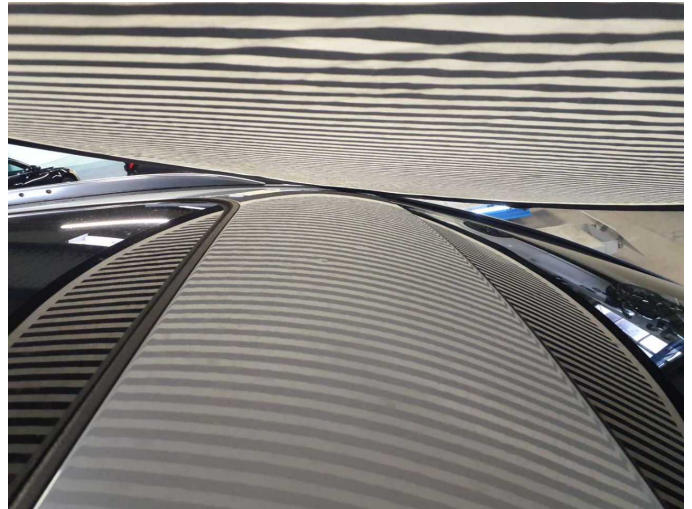
